

Statement of Impact of Governors at Christ Church C of E Primary School, North Shields

Governors have revised and shortened the school mission statement for clarity and agreed the school's 7 Christian Values and 5-point targets for improvement.

A higher profile for Governors, in response to parent and child questionnaires, has been addressed by Governors being assigned to classes, attending parents' evenings and being present at assemblies, events and accompanying class visits.

Governors are actively involved in all aspects of school life by regularly monitoring progress through data scrutiny and observation, preparing and updating school Policies and presenting reports on specific aspects of the curriculum and school performance.

As volunteers we are readily contactable by the school, reactive and pro-active, making every effort to attend all meetings and regularly participating in Local Authority training to keep knowledge up to date.

The Head Teacher was fully supported in creating a stronger Leadership Team to ensure all members of staff are given opportunities for career progression.

Governing Body minutes clearly show challenge to the Leadership Team and have been shared with other schools, by the Local Authority, as examples of good practice.
